

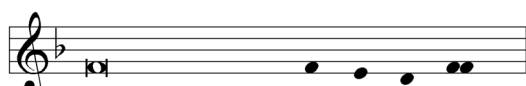
Midweek Advent Evening Prayer Service

Carols for the Newborn King

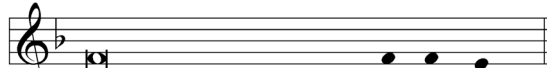
December 13, 2017
