### DIALOGUE OF PRAISE

- M Come, let us sing for joy to the Lord, let us shout aloud to the Rock of our salvation.

- M Do not be afraid. I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is Christ the Lord.


FIRST LESSON ISAIAH 52:7-10

SECOND LESSON HEBREWS 1:1-9

The writer to the Hebrews describes the Christ-child: God himself made flesh for the purification of sins and the rule of righteousness

<sup>1</sup>In the past God spoke to our forefathers through the prophets at many times and in various ways, <sup>2</sup>but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom he made the universe. <sup>3</sup>The Son is the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of his being, sustaining all things by his powerful word. After he had provided purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty in heaven. <sup>4</sup>So he became as much superior to the angels as the name he has inherited is superior to theirs.

<sup>5</sup>For to which of the angels did God ever say,
"You are my Son; today I have become your Father"?

Or again,

"I will be his Father, and he will be my Son"?

<sup>6</sup>And again, when God brings his firstborn into the world, he says, "Let all God's angels worship him." <sup>7</sup>In speaking of the angels he says, "He makes his angels winds, his servants flames of fire."

<sup>8</sup>But about the Son he says,

"Your throne, O God, will last for ever and ever, and righteousness will be the scepter of your kingdom.

9You have loved righteousness and hated wickedness; therefore God, your God, has set you above your companions by anointing you with the oil of joy."



<sup>10</sup>He was in the world, and though the world was made through him, the world did not recognize him. <sup>11</sup>He came to that which was his own, but his own did not receive him. <sup>12</sup>Yet to all who received him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God—

<sup>13</sup>children born not of natural descent, nor of human decision or a husband's will, but born of God.

<sup>14</sup>The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the One and Only, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.




