Moses Sees God's Holiness Exodus 33–34

THE LESSON

2. Share one example where you have made a choice.

5. What lesson/truth/message is the video presenting?
6. How did the video relate to this week's lesson theme: "God is holy and amazing. He has the ability to change us."

8. God and his Word can help us make good choices when faced with important decisions. What choices/decisions do you have coming up where God can help you?

Faith-Focusing Activities for Parents to Do with Their Kids

DOODLE PRAYERS

Carry a Magna Doodle drawing toy in your vehicle. On the way to school each morning (or to other places), have one of your kids be responsible for doodling personal prayer requests for the day. After you drop off your kids at school, pray for their needs. When you pick them up at the end of the day, let them know you prayed for them, and ask how things went.



GOD SIGHTING STICKS

To get kids talking about God sightings throughout their day, use popsicle or tongue depressor sticks to spark conversations with your kids after school, at supper, or before going to bed. Write the conversation prompts below on the sticks or on paper and glue them to the sticks. Have your kids pull out a stick, read the prompt out loud, and respond. Use a fun container to store the sticks.

- I showed someone God's love today when I...
- I experienced God's power today when...
- Today God helped me at school when...
- I trusted God today when...
- I know God loves me because today...
