WHAT?

Food collection for the Muskego Food Pantry to assist area families in need.

WHEN?

Sunday, May 17, 1:00-4:00 p.m.

WHERE?

St. Paul's Lutheran Church-Muskego at all three entrance locations.

HOW?

Drop off non-perishable (canned/packaged) items to help supply the Muskego Food Pantry. While any item is accepted, **items most needed** are listed below. Items must be in bags. If possible, use plastic bags.

- 1) After entering the campus, proceed to the food drop-off canopy.
- 2) Open your car door and place bagged items on the driveway.
- 3) Close your car door and slowly drive on.
- 4) St. Paul's volunteers will collect the bags after you drive off.
- 5) Volunteers will be wearing protective masks and gloves.
