Digging Into the Heart of God

This year, Kids Club students and staff will enjoy the third series in the four-part *Dig In* curriculum. In 2017-18, we used, "Digging into the Life of Jesus." Last year, we enjoyed, "Digging into the Bible in One Year." For 2019-20, we will experience, "Digging into the Heart of God." Weekly Bible lessons will showcase God's attributes and characteristics: God is faithful, God is wise, God is welcoming, etc. In 2020-21, we will complete the *Dig In* series with, "Epic Teachings of the Bible."

Both students and staff really get into these lessons and the Large Group/Small Group format we use to present them. In Large Group, all students come together in the Centennial Gym to hear the week's Bible lesson which includes music, singing, video, and demonstrations. After Large Group, students return to their individual classrooms for Small Group — a series of activities that reinforce the Large Group lesson in engaging ways.



This year, Kids Club will also use three Modified Large Group (MLG) Sundays to "switch-up" the weekly routine. On MLG Sundays, students of all ages come to the gym for a short introduction to the lesson. After the introduction, the students are divided into equal numbered, mixed-age groups (ages 4-12 together). These groups then rotate through four activity stations that relate to the main lesson. MLG Sundays are very fun and a real highpoint of the Kids Club calendar.

2019-2020 should be another exciting and fulfilling year of growing together as children, teens, adults. and families around God's Word.

MISSION OUTREACH IN VIETNAM

It all started when Zang Lou, a leader in the Hmong Fellowship Church (HFC) in Vietnam, viewed an online sermon by Wisconsin Evangelical Lutheran Synod (WELS) Pastor, Bounkeo Lor, in 2011. The clear message of pure grace through Jesus Christ was something he had never heard before, and he wanted to learn more. Zang Lou invited Pastor Lor to come to Vietnam to train the HFC in the truth of the gospel. Since 2012, Lor has made over 24 different trips to Hanoi, Vietnam.

The HFC was a church body of 55,000 members when Zang Lou first reached out to WELS. In the years WELS has provided training, the HFC has grown from 55,000 to over 100,000 members and formed many new churches. The Vietnamese government has now invited WELS to build a theological training facility in the capital city of Hanoi.

This is an incredible, unprecedented opportunity. WELS is currently the only protestant church with official government permission to work with the Hmong in Vietnam. The Lord is opening a door to reach the more than two million Hmong people who live in Vietnam and the surrounding countries.

This year, the weekly offerings children bring to Kids Club will go to the WELS Vietnam outreach effort.

This is done because the lessons are some of the core ones that lay a solid foundation for our youngest children. These lessons are also used because the 3K staff has been doing them for several years and has developed a fantastic array of craft and other reinforcement projects to go with them. Mrs. Vicky Gabrus has been leading the 3K team for many years and has put together some truly amazing projects for the 3K children to do with the lessons.

BOOST Class Dropped from Sunday Morning Schedule



Beginning this year, the 7th and 8th grade BOOST class will be dropped from the Sunday morning schedule. This is being done for a couple reasons.

Originally, BOOST was started as an additional "layer" of Bible education for the 7th and 8th grade public school students who are St. Paul's members and also attending the Wednesday afternoon Confirmation Instruction classes. Attending BOOST was one of the "requirements" for Confirmation of the public school youth. 7th-8th grade students of St. Paul's Lutheran School were welcome to attend as well, but only one or two ever did. This year, we are instituting some modifications and additions to the Wednesday Confirmation Instruction Program that will lessen the need to offer the additional Bible education experience.

We also found over the years that fewer and fewer students were attending BOOST regularly due to other, Sunday morning conflicts: competitive sports, family trips, shared custody arrangements between divorced parents, etc. These competing realities frequently found BOOST attendance to be less than 1/3 of the eligible students.

Though BOOST will be discontinued, interested 7th and 8th grade youth can still be a part of Sunday morning Kids Club by serving as teachers' aides for various classes. This may actually prove to be a great "pipeline" for keeping them as helpers once they enter high school. In 2019-2020, eight high school students will be part of the Kids Club staff.
