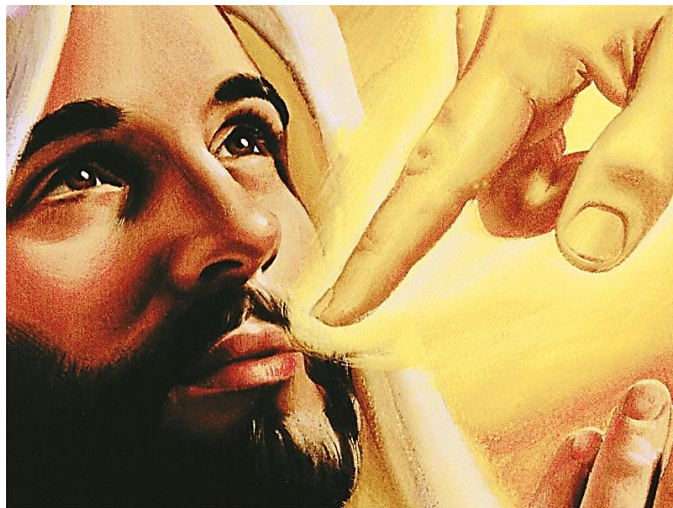


God Chooses Jeremiah Jeremiah 1:4-19
