


God Gives Jonah a Second Chance Jonah 1-4



Through the Week

- Work together to make a "fish fort" by building a blanket fort in a common area of your home.
- Throughout the week, when people need to pray about their attitudes, they can choose to go in the fish. (Don't send anyone to the fish—this should be self-awareness that they need help showing God's mercy.)
- When you're in the fish, pray about your attitude, just as Jonah did. Ask God to help you show mercy and let go of your bad attitude toward another person.

God tells Jonah to go to Nineveh and tell the 120,000 people there that they'll be destroyed unless they repent. Jonah runs away instead by ship, gets caught in a storm at sea, and is thrown overboard. Then, Jonah is swallowed by a fish. God gives Jonah a second chance and has the fish spit Jonah out after three days. Jonah realizes he should obey God this time and goes to Nineveh. Jonah preaches to the people and they change their ways. God spares the people of Nineveh. Jonah, however, does not like this. He feels God should punish them. God has to teach Jonah another lesson: a lesson on how God shows mercy, and Jonah should, too. God shows mercy even when we don't. Read the whole story in Jonah 1-4.
